
Dear Mr. Assefa:

In a letter dated March 18, 2025, you informed the Joint Legislative Budget Committee that Governor Newsom has determined that the Cornucopia Hybrid Project in Fresno County is eligible for the alternative California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review process authorized by SB 149 (Caballero), Chapter 60, Statutes of 2023.

Senate Bill 149 provides a streamlined CEQA review process for energy infrastructure, semiconductor and microelectronics, transportation-related, and water-related projects that meet certain requirements. For example, energy infrastructure projects must meet various labor and greenhouse gas emission-related requirements, and also must avoid or minimize impacts to disadvantaged communities.

Based on the information you have provided, and a subsequent review by the Legislative Analyst's Office, I concur with the Governor's determination that the project meets the SB 149 criteria set forth in Public Resources Code section 21189.80 et seq.
