List of State Entities Receiving Funding Pursuant to Section 19.56 (AB 102, Ch. 38/2023)

Pursuant to Section 19.56 of Chapter 38, Statutes of 2023, the Department of Finance respectfully submits Attachment 1, which identifies the state entities authorized to receive funding for their coordination efforts in facilitating the expenditure of funds designated in Sections 19.561 through 19.569 of Chapter 189, Statutes of 2023.

Attachment 1 identifies the state entity and the amount allocated to each, as determined by Finance. The amount provided to each state entity is a proportionate share of the \$7.5 million authorized in Section 19.56 based upon the number of legislative allocations assigned to each state entity. The value of one legislative allocation is \$14,478.

Finance requests an expedited review of the submission and a waiver of the 30-day waiting requirement.
