Notification of Receipt and Approval of an Unanticipated Cost Funding Request from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing

Pursuant to provisions 3 and 6 of Items 9840, we are transmitting to you within 15 days of receipt, the attached unanticipated cost funding request from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (Commission).

On August 10, 2022, the Commission reached a settlement in the case or *Carroll v. State of California*. The settlement agreement requires the Commission to make four (4) payments totaling \$3,300,000 according to the following schedule.

- \$350,000 during calendar year 2022 to Kathleen Carroll
- \$500,000 during calendar year 2022 to Metropolitan Tower Life Insurance Company
- \$2,100,000 during calendar year 2022 to the Siegel, Yee, Brunner, and Mehta Trust Account
- \$350,000 during calendar year 2023 to Kathleen Carroll

We have completed our review of the proposal and concur with the request. Funding for this unanticipated cost request will be provided from the 9840-001-0001, Augmentations for Contingencies or Emergencies, in the amount of \$3,300,000. Due to the constrained timeline of the settlement payments, we are requesting an expedited review from the Legislature.

(Use attachments if additional space is needed.) The Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) has reached a legal settlement in the case of Carroll v. CTC. The settlement		
requires CTC to pay a total of \$3,300,000, which is broken down as follows: \$350,000 to Kathleen Carroll in calendar year 2022, \$350,000 to Kathleen Carroll in the first quarter of calendar year 2023, \$2,100,000 to Siegel, Yee, Brunner, and Mehta Trust Account in calendar year 2022, and \$500,000 to Metropolitan Tower Life Insurance Company in calendar year 2022. The timing, payees, and amounts of each payment are material terms of the settlement that CTC must meet. While this has been a lengthy settlement, the settlement amount was not previously known and therefore, an unforeseen cost for CTC.
